## **Criteria for submission of your nominee:**

- Nominee must have been a member of the World Clown Association at least for the full year, 2010
- Nomination for the Clown of the Year must be limited to clowning activities within the last 5 years.
- What has the clown done for the World Clown Association within the last 5 years?
- Has the clown written articles for the magazine Clowning Around? If so, how often?
- Has the clown held office within the World Clown Association? If so, which ones?
- Has the clown participated in conventions, as a lecturer or delegate?
- What has the clown done to promote the World Clown Association locally, nationally, or internationally?
- What has the clown done to promote and perpetuate the art of clowning?
- What has the clown done with his or her art in community involvement?
- What has the clown done to help others to improve their appearances, clowning techniques or presentations?
- What awards has the clown received either through competition or community involvement?
- Each nomination should be limited to not more than one and one-half pages of information about the clown.
- Someone other than the individual nominated must make each nomination and be a member of World Clown Association A friend, Alley, or Regional Director are good resources for submission of nominations.
- Nominations must be accompanied with a picture of each nominee in clown makeup and costume. Pictures should be 5x7 or smaller.
